 EDH-Candidates must have successfully completed the basic training required by STCW Code A-VI/1

 EDH-Candidates must hold a Navigational Watch Rating Certificate; or a steering certificate; or proof of having obtained sufficient experience

 EDH-Candidates must meet the medical fitness requirements

EDH-Candidates must have

- Seamanship – Rope types & construction, knots, bends & hitches, rigging a bosun's chair and stage, rope and wire splicing, whipping and seizing, parceling and servicing.
