Course description	The course includes general construction and functions of the various parts of the human body, medical store on board a ship, basic principles relating to pharmacology and dealing with accidents or other medical emergencies and the application of immediate first aid.
Course programme	Conducted in a dedicated medical training classroom.
Duration	3 days
Assessment	Assessment is by individual participation and multiple-choice type written exam.
