This course will give new seafarers an insight into the various elements of a ship and working procedures on board so that they can adjust to the shipboard environment and are better prepared to cope with any unforeseen circumstances.

This course is planned to make their transition from a shore to a sea career as smooth as possible and provide some understanding of a seafarers working environment and the hazards, procedures and safe working practices they will encounter before they step on board a ship.
